Mimi and the Dragon

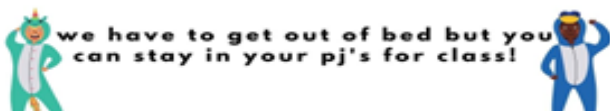
