Next week, starting on Tuesday 12th November until Thursday 14th November, our KS2 children can compete at home on Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS) in the 'England Rocks' competition.

How does it work?

The children will try to answer as many multiplication and division questions correctly as they can. The winning school and class will be based on the highest average number of correct answers per pupil.

Rules:

1. Every correct answer that a student gives, in any game type, between the hours of 7:30am GMT to 7:30pm GMT each day will contribute to their class and school score.
2. There is a 60-minute limit playtime per player, per day.
3. Each class has a minimum player count of 10. If fewer than 10 in the class play in the competition, their total will be divided by 10 regardless.

The winning children will receive certificates and Amazon vouchers.

Please encourage your KS2 child to have a go, as it will also boost their maths confidence alongside accuracy and recall speed.
